Nicole Birthelmer opened the meeting and discussed the balance. As of the week prior, the balance is \$28,265.18.

Kristina Huvar spoke about the garden. She has been working on it since this summer. This Friday, she will help hand out pinecones for the students to make bird feeders in conjunction with the fundraiser. Next week, she will start planting seeds. We also now have an outdoor sink thanks to local Boy Scouts who built it by hand.

The group discussed the idea of a special garden distribution in honor of Earth Day. We will need to plan for 660+ kits. Kristina will start planning that immediately so that whatever seeds we distribute will have time to bloom for Earth Day on April 22.

Laurie Beeler spoke about the Eagle Challenge. \$5,960 has been raised so far. So far registration and participation is low, so members will all try to boost awareness and push for participation between students, parents, and teachers. Prizes will be given for money raised, Bingo cards (either regular Bingos or blackouts), and minutes of reading/exercise/kindness tracked.
