Nicole also presented the Treasurer's report. We have a current balance of \$40,764.90. Our projected budget for next year is \$47,429.62.

The fifth grade sign design contest is accepting designs until April 6. Voting will be held April 8-14, and the winner will be announced on the 15th. Families will be able to pre-order shirts with the same design April 15-20. Delivery will be May 15.

The Krispy Kreme fundraiser is set for April, with orders being taken April 1-15. Donuts will be distributed April 24 from 8-9 am. The CSA box fundraiser is slotted for May, with details still being finalized.

Nicole turned the meeting over to Principal Hightower, who introduced herself and Vice Principal, Jessie Salas. Irene proceeded with a Power Point presentation to explain most of the initial details of the Phase 2 re-opening of the school, and then opened the meeting up to questions from parents about any details not already covered in the presentation. Some of the information presented and discussed during the meeting will be made available on the Hancock website and the PTF Facebook page.

Nicole briefly spoke on the PTF's plans for re-opening. We have purchased 29 thermometers for use by the teachers and staff. The weekend before campus re-opens, there will be a "Chalk the Walk" event as well as a sign hanging. Any families
