

Hancock Elementary PTF general meeting
November 17, 2020

Called to order: 4:00 pm

Nicole Birthelmer opened the meeting with a thank you to everyone for the Drive-by in Disguise and welcomed Ms. Cimins.

Ms. Cimins spoke about the "Fun Run" fundraiser. She discussed alternate ideas, as well as how each would work with online tracking through the company we typically use. There would be less prizes given, as we cannot have daily prize patrol like is typical in a normal school year. However, there are options for better prizes and more humorous faculty incentives. She suggested a January start, will the fundraiser ending in February.

The group decided to open the yet-to-be-officially named "whatever"-a-thon on January 11, 2021 and close on February 12, 2021

The group unanimously approved the budget changes.

Hary spoke about the Hancock face masks. The pre-order opened November 16th. It will run until December 6th. In order to encourage pre-orders, the price will go up \$1 after the pre-order window closes.

Maribel spoke about fundraisers. 25 boxes and 18 bundles of strawberries were purchased from the farm box fundraiser.

Nicole spoke about the Saturday distribution on November 21. Farm boxes will be distributed, as well as t-shirts, comic books, and books. Penguin Patch flyers will also be handed out at the time to promote the fundraiser, which opens November 23 and closes December 7.

Nicole spoke more about the Penguin Patch. They will give us 10% of the profits, which is an increase on last year's 5%. We have a significant amount of points accumulated, which when added to the points from this year, we can use to buy items for the school. Everything will be online and shipped to the families, with online measures so that the parents can checkout without seeing what was purchased for them.

Maribel discussed the December materials distribution. There have been no donations yet. If we do not receive donations, counting for 675 students to come through, we would spend \$275 out of PTF funds.

There will be a Spirit Week the last week of school before the holiday break. It was kick off on December 14 and end on December 18, with a pajama day for the drive through materials distribution.

The next PTF Board meeting will be December 8 at 4:00 pm. The next PTF general meeting is December 15 at 4:00 pm.
